Thrift Shop Cashier: If you love the Thrift Shop, join our volunteer team! Volunteer cashiers welcome patrons as they enter the shop, and complete patron transactions using Apple Square technology. Volunteers must have excellent customer service skills and be comfortable handling cash and credit card sales. **We are currently seeking volunteers for substitute shifts throughout the week (variable times).** Beginning in **September**, we will have opportunities available from 9:30 AM – 12:00 PM, Monday – Friday.

Thrift Shop Merchandiser: Join the behind-the-scenes team for the Thrift Shop! Volunteer Merchandisers help stock the shelves and hang clothes before the Shop opens. Volunteers must be comfortable working with minimal supervision. **We are currently seeking volunteers for Wednesday or Friday morning from 10:00 – 11:45 AM and Saturday morning from 9:00 – 10:00 AM.**

Calling all Crafters: Over the summer, we are offering kids crafts on Thursday mornings from 9:30 – 11:30, as families pick up supplemental food from the Food Pantry. We are looking for volunteers to manage the Thursday morning crafts. Participant numbers will vary, but we expect approximately 20 kids in a 2-hour time frame. We are also taking suggestions for easy, fun, kid friendly projects that can be completed quickly and then replicated again with minimal set up. **If you have the crafty-gene and a little free time on a Thursday morning, please let us know!**

Age-Friendly Freeport Pownal (AFFP): AFFP is seeking volunteers to **assist with various committees and activities.** Duties include forming connections between AFFP and other community organizations, helping with monthly events like bingo and socials, putting up flyers for events, etc. Total time commitment is likely 4 – 6 hours per month. Transportation Program Driver: Transportation to and from necessary resources and appointments is one of the major needs for our Age-Friendly program. **We use an on-line platform to schedule rides, so basic computer skills are necessary for transportation volunteers.** Drivers must be 18 years old with reliable transportation, a valid license and proof of insurance. FCS will complete a mandatory background check for all drivers.
